Services and Supplies

Our services are free, with all money being raised through donations and fund-raising. The money we raise stays in Knox, Laurel, and Whitley counties.

Everyone with the Tri-County Cancer Coalition is a volunteer, no one is paid for their time or resources. This allows us to put contributions and donations directly to work for the region.

The Tri-County Cancer Coalition provides services such as: linking individuals to screening services, cancer patient support, cancer education and information, linking individuals to tobacco cessation programs in Knox, Laurel, and Whitley Counties.

Transportation funds are available for cancer patients traveling to and from medical appointments.

Wigs, bandanas, turbans, scarfs, lymphedema sleeves, breast prosthesis and bras, nicotine replacement therapy medications, nutritional supplements, and other products may be available to cancer patients as well.

All of our services and supplies are funded through donations and grant funding. Services available will depend on current funding.
